AMERICAN COUNCIL FOR CONSTRUCTION EDUCATION

The American Council for Construction Education (ACCE) is a 501(c)(3) private non-profit corporation. The mission of ACCE is to be a leading global advocate of quality construction education; and to promote, support, and accredit quality construction education programs. The primary goal is promotion and continued improvement of postsecondary construction education; specifically, ACCE accredits construction education programs in colleges and universities that request its evaluation and meet its standards and criteria.

ACCE is recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) as the accrediting agency for both 4-year baccalaureate degree programs and two-year associate degree programs in construction, construction science, construction management, and construction technology. The Council offers accreditation for Master Degree Programs and Recognition of Continuing Education courses for Non-Degree Programs.

Organized in 1974 by the American Institute of Constructors, the constructor's professional organization, and the Associated Schools of Construction, ACCE enjoys the support of the principal building and contracting national associations and academic institutions seeking to satisfy the needs for well educated and trained entrants into the construction profession.

By working together under the aegis of ACCE, persons representative of the total construction community and the public at large, construction educators and constructors, establish and maintain standards and criteria for accreditation, provide guidance to those seeking to achieve accredited status, and carry out the accreditation and reaccreditation processes. In doing so, ACCE serves the interests of potential students by helping them identify institutions and programs that offer quality education in the field, and serves the interests of the industry by enabling employers to identify persons who, by reason of their education and training, have the potential for making lasting contributions to the industry and their profession. ACCE also serves the interests of owners/users of constructed facilities and the public at large by raising the professional caliber of constructors and thus the quality of the construction for which they assume responsibility.

ACCE has developed reciprocal agreements with the National Board for Construction Management Accreditation (NBCMA) of the People's Republic of China, the Canadian Technological Accreditation Board (CTAB), and The Chartered Institute of Builders (CIOB) in the United Kingdom. The agreements recognize university degree programs accredited by NBCMA, CTAB, and CIOB as equivalent to Baccalaureate Degree Programs or Associate Degree Programs accredited by ACCE and the same equivalency for NBCMA, CTAB, and CIOB accredited Degree Programs.

These agreements are the culmination of a long period of evaluation by all parties embracing academic standards' comparability, exchange of procedural information and reciprocal observation of accreditation visits.





PRESIDENT'S REPORT



Being over 40 years old (not me, ACCE!), the American Council for Construction Education has seen many changes, made many changes

and continues to evolve with the times. Last year, we implemented a dramatic change in the governance of the Council. This year, we are transitioning from a prescriptive set of standards into a hybrid set of outcomes-based standards and assessment processes. With the transition plan, programs were given the option to be evaluated under the old or new standards for the fall 2015 and spring 2016 semesters. Stating in the fall of 2016, all programs must be evaluated under the new OBS assessment processes.

The Council now has an opponent (competition): the Applied Sciences Accreditation Commission of ABET has now received approval for their construction management criteria and is beginning to accredit CM programs. Their criterion

seems less rigorous and their program evaluators (PEVs) are restricted to CMAA members and CMAA-trained educators. As they are part of the engineering community, it will be interesting to see how they evolve and how programs chose to be accredited and focused, either agency-cmoriented (5% of the market), or aimed at the construction industry as a whole (95% of the market).

At our Long Beach meeting, we held the 6th annual IAB Workshop. Again a successful effort, this workshop continues to support our programs and reinforces the impact that a strong Industry Advisory Board can have on the quality education provided by our programs.

ACCE awarded 2 scholarships during this year: the Dupree Education Fund awarded Levla Naimi from Cal Poly and Stanford a \$3,000 scholarship. Being an employee of Morley Builders, Leyla will continue her pursuit to giving back to the construction industry.

Melissa Thevernin from Colorado State was award a \$5,000 scholarship as part of the NHE/ ACCE scholarship program. Melissa is working on her PhD to develop curriculum and content for construction classes as her contribution to the industry. Her residential work background will serve the industry well.

ACCE continues to grow, with 76 4-year programs, 13 2-year programdsand 4 master degree programs. Candidates include 10 4-year programs, 3 2-year programs and one master degree program in consideration.

We want to thank each of our volunteers for his/her support. ACCE is strong and viable, having the dedication and passion of the construction industry as the foundation to build upon.
