ANNUAL REPORT 2008 - 2009

The American Council for Construction Education (ACCE) is a 501(c)(3) private non-profit corporation. The mission of ACCE is to be a leading global advocate of quality construction education; and to promote, support, and accredit quality construction education programs. The primary goal is promotion and continued improvement of postsecondary construction education; specifically, ACCE accredits construction education programs in colleges and universities that request its evaluation and meet its standards and criteria.

ACCE is recognized by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) as the accrediting agency for both 4-year baccalaureate degree programs and two-year associate degree programs in construction, construction science, construction management, and construction technology.

Organized in 1974 by the American Institute of Constructors, the constructor’s professional organization, and the Associated Schools of Construction, ACCE enjoys the support of the principal building and contracting national associations and academic institutions seeking to satisfy the needs for well educated and trained entrants into the construction profession.

By working together under the aegis of ACCE, persons representative of the total construction community and the public at large, construction educators and constructors, establish and maintain standards and criteria for

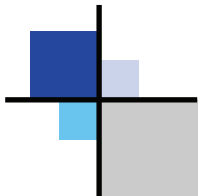
accreditation, provide guidance to those seeking to achieve accredited status, and carry out the accreditation and reaccreditation processes. In doing so, ACCE serves the interests of potential students by helping them identify institutions and programs that offer quality education in the field, and serves the interests of the industry by enabling employers to identify persons who, by reason of their education and training, have the potential for making lasting contributions to the industry and their profession. ACCE also serves the interests of owners/users of constructed facilities and the public at large by raising the professional caliber of constructors and thus the quality of the construction for which they assume responsibility.

ACCE has developed reciprocal agreements with the Chartered Institute of Building (CIOB) of the United Kingdom, the National Board for Construction Management Accreditation (NBCMA) of the People’s Republic of China, and the Canadian Technological Accreditation Board (CTAB). The agreements recognize university degree programs accredited by CIOB, NBCMA, and CTAB as equivalent to Baccalaureate Degree Programs or Associate Degree Programs accredited by ACCE and the same equivalency for CIOB, NBCMA, and CTAB accredited Degree Programs.

These agreements are the culmination of a long period of evaluation by all parties embracing academic standards’ comparability, exchange of procedural information and reciprocal observation of accreditation visits.

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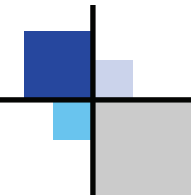

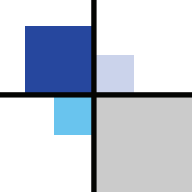

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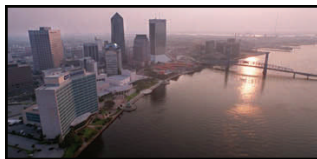

The years 2008-2009 were tough for many of us and certainly for many programs around the country due to a continuation of budget cuts and a general increase of enrollment in our programs. Further, industry support has been reduced in both giving and hiring – all of this impacting our students and programs. We share the challenges with all our programs and know the pendulum will swing again, in the other direction and we will continue to work with our programs to assist in whatever way we can.

For the American Council for Construction Education, this year has been a good year. We have continued to stay involved with the international community, having new and returning visitors from Chile with continued interest and involvement with our accreditation processes. We receive at least one inquiry a month from other countries interested in accreditation for CM programs.

We completed our three year document review. This included: changing standards regarding student learning outcomes within a program's perspective; added clarity of remote/split campuses; and distance learning programs. We continued our task force work on piloting graduate degree accreditation with two additional programs in the pilot: University of Florida and Texas A&M University.

The Non-degree Recognition Task Force came of age and is now a committee. We have the two initial recognized providers renewing their recognition, and we have one new provider and two candidates entering the fold. I believe this increases the awareness of industry for ACCE and will continue to attract new participants from industry. Keep in mind that the Non-degree recognition is only for non skill-based education. We will work to assure the quality of these providers and the recognition of the efforts of all who participate in this endeavor.

We have launched our effort to be reaf-

firmed by the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA) with a working group making the initial application in January 2010, looking for reaffirmation in January 2011.

The Dupree Construction Education Fund of ACCE was blessed by receiving a grant from the National Housing Endowment (NHE), the philanthropic arm of the National Association of Home Builders (NAHB) to support future faculty members focusing on residential construction. The \$25,000 grant award will go to applicants who fit the profile which both ACCE and NHE see as the future. For the school year 2009-10, the NHE/ACCE scholarship was awarded to two graduate students with residential backgrounds. They are: Ben Bigelow at Colorado State and Charles 'Rick' Nightingale from Indiana State. Both are committed to residential construction and will be leaders for the future grads in construction management. Five of our programs received the Housing Education Leadership Program (H.E.L.P.) grants from NHE in 2009. The H.E.L.P. program continues to be a great supporter of our quality Construction Management programs which are focused on increasing the residential elements of construction and are preparing new graduates to be better qualified for a career in the residential industry.

An additional Dupree Scholarship was awarded to Justin Weidman, a graduate student at Brigham Young University working within the Construction Management Department in pursuing his career as a faculty member. All three of our scholarship award winners received \$5,000 going toward the cost of their graduate education.

Dustin Stephany, the 2008 Regnier Fellowship recipient, completed his research on "Designing for Deconstruction" and will make a presentation at the February 2010 meeting in Albuquerque.

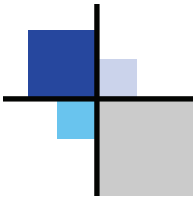
A task force from our Development Committee has created a workshop for industry-only participants for the February 2010 meeting. The purpose is to

create an environment where industry folks can share their experiences with a program's Industry Advisory Board and learn from others. The one-day commitment in Albuquerque will be a great experience for those who attend.

During the year 2008-2009, we reaccredited 14 programs, accredited two new programs, processed 25 progress reports, and increased our candidate group from 12 to 19 programs including six 2-year programs (up from four). We have changed committee chairs and members, with a couple of notable changes: Jim Smith as Accreditation Committee chair taking over from Carl Roegner. Carl did a GREAT job and we want to give him a big THANKS for his efforts. Jim is learning how much work goes into the accreditation efforts. Abdol Chini and Diane Slattery are taking over the Standards Committee and Guidance Committees from Desmond Fletcher and Fred Gould, respectively. Again, our thanks go to Desmond and Fred for their work. Other committee chairs changed as well and we want to think all of them for their participation and look forward to their continued work on other committees. Without the efforts of all our participants, ACCE could not function. It is with the talents and time shared by all our folks which makes our accreditation process work.

With that, I look forward to the next two years leading the American Council for Construction Education. My plans include continuing our success in quality education through the peer review process, strengthening the programs, and providing the graduates and their employers a strong foundation for the future in the construction industry.

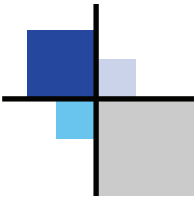

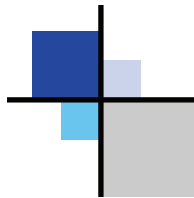

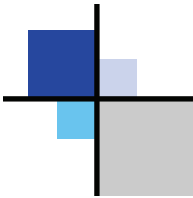
